#### **Open Air Service**

On the first Sunday every August for many years the whole Magheracloone community together with others who have connections with the area and the in particular the graveyard have gathered to mark St. Molua's Day.

This year, as we stand among the reminders of those who have gone before us the Rev Paul Hoey will be pointing us to those who come after us. He is the CPAS Representative in Ireland and heads up Church 21.

CPAS, the Churches Pastoral Aid Society has been producing literature for over a century now helping the church to develop and meets the challenges that arise. Church 21 is the initiative set up by our Bishop's to encourage parish development. #### **Harvest Thanksgivings**

This year there will be a Mission emphasis at our three harvest thanksgiving services. We have representatives from various societies coming to preach to emphasise again that a parish which does not have a mission emphasis is flying on one wing!

On Sunday 16th September at 3.00pm in Ardragh we hope to have a speaker from CMSI and on Sunday 23rd September at 7.00pm we hope to have a different speaker provided by CMSI. CMSI, Church Missionary Society Ireland. a long history of sending missionaries mainly to Africa and India. Our new Nigerian parishioners in Mallow had all heard of CMS and knew the work it had done in bringing to gospel to some of the more inaccessible parts of that country.

Mission has changed totally since the early days and we look forward to getting a new and clearer vision of what is involved today and what might be expected of us. On Sunday October 7.00pm at Carrickmacross our preacher will be from USPG. The United Society for the Propagation of the Gospel is the oldest Missionary Society in our church but recently it had more or less disappeared from view Ireland. They currently have a new active committee representative and we look forward to hearing from them something of what the Lord has been doing through them.
